Notice is hereby given that Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils are carrying out a consultation in relation to the Babergh and Mid Suffolk Joint Local Plan. The consultation is being carried out under Regulation 18 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. The consultation is running from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2017 until **5pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2017**.

#### **WHAT IS THE JOINT LOCAL PLAN?**

The Joint Local Plan will relate to the area covered by Babergh District Council and Mid Suffolk District Council. The Joint Local Plan will set out planning policies for the two Districts up to 2036. It will identify the amount of development required and allocate sites for development.
